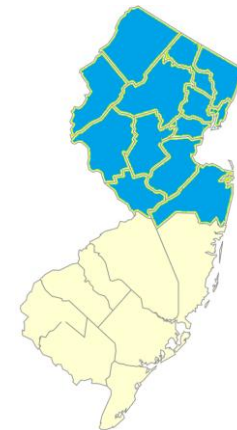

APIC was founded in 1972 by a pioneering group of infection control nurses who recognized the need for an organized approach to preventing healthcare-associated infection.

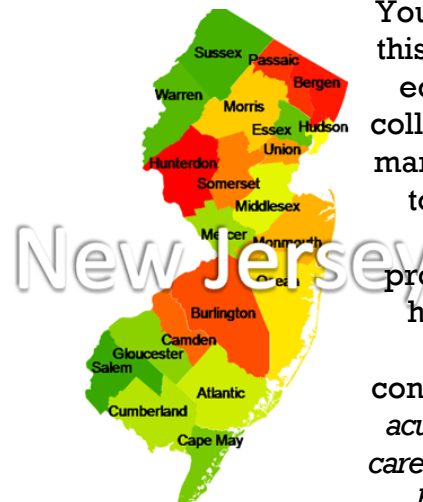
Members come from various backgrounds - nurses, physicians, public health professionals, epidemiologists, microbiologists, or medical technologists.
